Pre-requisite:

- 1. Must be a veteran or widow of a veteran who was honorably discharged and who served at least 90 days and at least 1 of those 90 days was during the following time periods, i.e. during wartime
 - a. 12/7/41 to 12/31/46
 - b. 6/27/50 to 1/31/55
 - c. 8/5/64 to 5/7/75
- 2. Amount of Net worth not to exceed \$80,000 for a couple and \$50,000 for a single person.
- 3. For widow, must have been married to the veteran at the time of his death
- 4. Medical Expenses exceed income. The following count as medical expenses:
 - a. Prescriptions
 - b. Health Insurance Premium
 - c. Medicare Premium
 - d. Incontinence Briefs
 - e. Assisted Living Expenses: up to 73% of assisted living fees count toward medical expenses

Information/Documentation Required:

- 1. Discharge Papers
- 2. Social Security number of Veteran; widow's SSN if applicable
- 3. Veteran's Date of Birth
- 4. Veteran's address & phone No.; or Widow's address & phone no.
- 5. Marriage information, as applicable
- 6. Letter from Assisted Living Home
 - a. Date entered
 - b. Level of Care
 - c. Cost per day
- 7. Medical Information
- 8. Financial Information
